

## **Statute 2.11 The Course Incubator**

- (1) There shall be a Course Incubator to enable the staged development of academic programs in disciplines new to ACU.
- (2) The Course Incubator functions as a precursor to the development of new academic work units.
- (3) Academic programs developed through the Course Incubator will be overseen by the Provost and Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic).
- (4) There shall be an Academic Lead for each program developed through the Course Incubator appointed by the Provost and Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic).
- (5) The functions and responsibilities of the Course Incubator include (subject always to the <u>Constitution</u> and any Statutes or Regulations made by the Senate):
  - a. delivering the teaching, examining and assessment in units for the Degrees, Certificates and Graduate Certificates, Diplomas and Graduate Diplomas and other award courses of the Incubator, as well as microcredentials.
  - b. making recommendations to the Academic Board on award regulations, course development and course changes;
  - c. authorising examination and assessment results and the determination of student progress;
  - d. encouraging and facilitating scholarship and research;
  - e. submitting to the Academic Board recommendations on any matters concerning teaching, scholarship and research undertaken through the Course Incubator;
  - f. considering and reporting on any matters referred to it by the Academic Board.
- (6) A standing committee of the Academic Board will support the Course Incubator to fulfill the functions of a Faculty Board as outlined in clause 10 of <u>Statute 2.6 Governing Bodies: The Faculties</u>.
- (7) Programs developed through the Course Incubator will transition to School or Faculty status at a time determined by the Vice-Chancellor and President and per the approval process outlined in the relevant Statute.
